Our voting decisions are informed by our bottom-up analysis, as well as best-practice corporate governance principles. We believe that proxy voting is a key component of being an active owner and are committed to consistently exercising our voting rights. Following a busy second quarter, the third quarter is usually the quietest the year regarding proxy votes. This year was no exception. In the third quarter of 2025, two shareholder meetings were held covering 40 management proposals.


